

13. <b>Muhammad</b> had sex with a nine year old girl that he had married at the age of six. (Bukhari 3895, 5133)	⇔	13. Jesus said to suffer the innocence of little children, for such are in His Kingdom of Heaven. (Matthew 19:14)
14. <b>Muhammad</b> told his followers that they could beat their wives into submission. (QUR'AN 4:34; IBN Majah 1986)	⇔	14. <b>Jesus</b> endured beatings, torture and death for our sins to be forgiven and that we might willingly be submissive to God. (Mark 10:45: Hebrews 12:2)
15. <b>Muhammad</b> had at least nine wives at one time even though his own revelations only allowed four. (Bukhari 268, 5068 5215)	⇔	15. <b>Jesus</b> commanded his followers to only take one wife, while he remained unmarried to fulfill his earthly ministry. (Matthew 19:6).
16. <b>Muhammad</b> married the wife of his own adopted son after causing the divorce allowed temporary marriages and commanded violence. (Sura 33:37; 4:24, 74, 76, 3, 34; QUR'AN 33:37; Tabari 8: 2-3)	⇔	16. Jesus commanded his followers to only take one wife, and not to divorce, and remarry for any reason other than continued adultery. 17. <b>Muhammad</b> broke a promise he made to his wives that he would stop having sex with slave girls. (QUR'AN 66:1-2; Nasa'I 3411) Muhammad had sex with his slave girls. (QUR'AN 33:50)	⇔	17. Jesus protected women. (Matthew 26:10, John 8:1-11)
18. <b>Muhammad</b> allowed his followers to rape their female captives. (QUR'AN 4:24; Abu Dawud 2155). Muhammad took the most beautiful captives back to his own tent. (Bukhari 4200: IBN Ishaq 466).	⇔	18. <b>Jesus</b> confronted and rebuked oppressors. (Matthew 23:1-33)
19. <b>Muhammad</b> brought pain and suffering to women. (Sura 4:34, 4:20; 2:223; 33:52; 64:14; 2:228-230)	⇔	19. Jesus broke down the barriers that kept people divided by gender. (Galatians 3:28)

20. <b>Muhammad</b> bought, sold, owned and traded black African slaves. (Bukhari 6161,7263)	⇔	20. <b>Jesus</b> gave hope to the oppressed. (Luke 4:16-21)
21. <b>Muhammad</b> called Ethiopians "Raisin Heads" and claimed that Satan looks like a black man. (IBN Ishaq 343: Bukhari 7142)	⇔	21. Jesus broke down the barriers that kept people divided by race and class. (Galatians 3:28)
22. <b>Muhammad</b> had no power over nature.	⇔	22. Jesus had all power over nature, (Mark 4:35-41; John 6:1-14; 6:15-21; Matthew 14:22-36) walked on water, (Mark 6:45-52) and could calm storms by speaking. (Matthew 8:23).
23. <b>Muhammad</b> performed no miracles, according to the Qur'an (Sura 13:7). Muhammad made people lame. (Bukhari Vol 8, Hadith 794; Vol. 9, Hadith 37)	⇔	23. Jesus healed all sicknesses. (Luke 13:11; 17:11-19; 22:50, 51; John 4:46-54; John 9; Matt 8:5-13; 15:29-31; Mark 3:1-5; 6:56), gave hearing to the deaf, (Matthew 11:45; Mark 7:32-35) made the lame walk, (Matthew 15:30-31; Luke 7:22) gave sight to the blind. 24. <b>Muhammad</b> commanded peace when he was weak at the start, (Sura 2:256; 109:1-6; 6:107-109) but violence when he grew powerful. 26. <b>Muhammad</b> prayed for forgiveness 70 times a day (Sura 40:55, 47:19; Bukhari; Vol. 8; Hadith 319 and Abu Dawud Vol. 1; Hadith 1511)	⇔	26. <b>Jesus</b> was sinless. (Matt 27:4,19, 24; John 8:46; 9:16; see also Sura 19:19)

Jesus said that Truth would set us free. In the beginning Almighty God made all things and gave all living things life through His Word. By the same Word, He entrusted to mankind in a perfect world a fundamental Law of perfect love that instilled in us a conscience based morality that sets us above the animals, giving to us a free will to obey and love Him.
